This MOU is entered into on the 24th day of JULY, 2018 by and between Anwarul Uloom college of Business Management, New Malleshpally, Hyderabad, Telangana (First Party)

And

Aizza College Of Engineering & Technology, Mulkalla (V), Hajipur(M), Mancherial, Telangana (Second Party)

The aforesaid institutions are hereinafter referred to individually as institute and collectively as institutes.

1. Objectives of the MOU

The objectives of the MOU are:

- a) To promote and enhance academic interest between Anwarul Uloom college of Business Management & Aizza College of Engineering & Technology.
- b) To provide advice for implementation of quality of education at both the institutions.
- c) To promote research/continuing education activities between institutions.

2. Technical Areas of Collaboration

- a) A Continuing Quality Improvement Programme to improve quality of teaching staff at both the institutions through short-term/long-term courses.
- b) Provide academic interaction by delivering Special Lectures on topics of relevance to modern Industry.
- c) Provide necessary help in Organizing Workshops/conferences and Personality Development Programmes for enhancement of skills in respect of Faculty, Staff and Students of the institutes
- d) Provide necessary support for establishment of Video satellite link and assistance in development of E-class rooms, Lab, Curriculum, establishment of research Labs, Training & Placement and Library etc.
- e) Usage of academic infrastructure for students and faculty members.
- f) Guidance for enhancement in infrastructural development.
- g) Jointly supervision of students for skill development.

3. Proposed Modes of Collaboration

Anwarul Uloom college of Business Management proposes to collaborate through the following:

- a) Cooperation and promotion of education and training in areas of mutual interest.
- b) Any other appropriate mode of Interaction agreed upon between Anwarul Uloom college of Business Management and Aizza College of Engineering & Technology.

A specific plan will be worked out by the institutes depending upon availability of resources. A specific agreement will be entered into for each activity.

4. Terms and Conditions

- a) The faculty members and students of institutions can use the library facility for short-time.
- b) Usage of academic infrastructure can be allowed for limited period subject to its availability, approval of Head of the facility/department and Institute norms.
- c) Both institutes agree to help, identify and invite the faculty members and researchers from the other institutes to participate in conferences, workshops and short-term courses.
- d) This MOU may be amended, renewed and terminated by mutual written agreement of the institutes at any time.

e) Either Institute shall have the right to terminate this MOU upon 3 months prior written notice to the other Institute.

5. Confidentiality

Both the parties agree to hold in confidence all information/data designated by the institutes as being confidential which is obtained from either Institute or created during the performance of the MOU and will not disclose the same to any third party without other institute.

6. Duration of MOU

The duration of this Memorandum of Understanding ("MOU"), shall be remained unless and until terminated by either of the party after giving three (3) months prior notice in written.

7. Intellectual Property Rights

The intellectual property rights (IPR) that arise as a result of joint research and collaborative activity under the agreement will be worked out on a case to case basis and will be consistent with officially laid down IPR policies of the two institutes.
